## AN ACT

13	<u>"Custodial child care facility." A child day care CENTER AS</u> <—
14	DEFINED UNDER SECTION 1001 OF THE ACT OF JUNE 13, 1967 (P.L.31,
15	NO.21), KNOWN AS THE PUBLIC WELFARE CODE, or nursery school
16	licensed or regulated by the Commonwealth.

3 (g) Plans.--Every school district and custodial child care 4 facility, in cooperation with the local Emergency Management 5 Agency and the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency, shall develop and implement a comprehensive disaster response and 6 emergency preparedness [plans.] plan consistent with the 7 8 guidelines developed by the Pennsylvania Emergency Management 9 Agency and other pertinent State requirements. The plan shall be reviewed annually and modified as necessary. A copy of the plan 10 11 shall be provided to the county emergency management agency.

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
